


















Stream

"YouTube" of the enterprise; provides intelligent video storage with search, transcription and more.

Capabilities

- Stores and shares private corporate video messages
- Discover content from meeting recordings using keywords in spoken text

Pros

- YouTube like experience with channels, likes and commenting
- Automatic transcription with closed captioning
- Facial recognition with timeline
- Microsoft Teams meeting recordings will be automatically stored in Stream.

Cons

- Doesn't support enterprise branding
- No add-ins, extensibility available

- Private listings on YouTube
- Other video providers targeted towards internal communications



Sway

Next generation
visually rich
newsletters,

Capabilities

- Provide media rich department newsletters and reports
- Project status reports
- One-page microsite for new service offerings

Pros

- Interactive, media rich, web based authoring
- Supports images and videos

Cons

- Doesn't support enterprise branding
- No add-ins, extensibility available
- Doesn't integrate with much else in O365
- Not as powerful as PowerPoint

Replaces

PowerPoint, Word or Microsites



SharePoint Online

Share and manage content to empower teams to quickly find information and collaborate across the company using modern sites

Capabilities

 Communications mechanism to share news and updates from service areas, initiatives, functional groups, projects, teams, etc.

Pros

- Interactive, media rich, web based authoring
- Integrates with many services throughout Office 365
- Similar rich experience in mobile apps

Cons

- Has a bad name inside many organizations
- Not ideal as an enterprise intranet: no hierarchy, templated pages, personalization, etc. MSFT making great improvements

Replaces

WordPress/Microsites



Delve

Intelligent document discovery and employee profiles

Capabilities

- Find and connect with fellow employees
- Discover content a person is interacting with, in relation to what I am doing
- Quickly find shared documents

Pros

- Displays files the person is interacting with which is relevant to you
- Personalized results per person
- Returns files from Outlook, SharePoint Online, and OneDrive

Cons

- People search is limited to name only
- Cannot customize interface
- Does not integrate with other data platforms, cannot feed in additional content

- Custom people search
- Traditional search



Forms

User friendly simple survey, poll and quiz tool.

Capabilities

- Gather feedback
- Rapidly analyze feedback and results
- Confirm knowledge and retention

Pros

- Clean, click to build, interface, no code required
- Automatically track authenticated users or keep anonymous
- Can write directly to an Excel file hosted in SharePoint Online
- Allows users to fill out the form in Microsoft Teams and SharePoint Online

Cons

 Limited survey capabilities in comparison to mainstream survey tools, i.e. no pagination

- Custom data entry forms
- 3rd party survey tools





PowerApps

Power user driven, no code, mobile app and custom form creation tool.

Capabilities

- Enabling business logic in data entry forms
- Allows users access to many cloud and on-prem data stores in a single application
- Custom forms within SharePoint

Pros

- Clean, click to build, interface, no code required
- Integrates with hundreds of SaaS providers as well as onprem data
- Use on mobile devices and leverage some capabilities, i.e. GPS, camera

Cons

- Tends to be slow
- Doesn't support all mobile native capabilities

- InfoPath (deprecated)
- Custom data entry forms and mobile apps



Flow

Power user driven workflow and task automation and process orchestration tool.

Capabilities

- Central location for content approval across enterprise
- Daily or weekly data query and dissemination
- Automate your day to day to week to week

Pros

- Clean, click to build, interface, no code required
- Powerful approval functionality
- Integrates with hundreds of SaaS providers as well as onprem data
- Accessible on mobile devices: review and approve content as well as manage flows

Cons

Limited service account support

- SharePoint Designer workflows (deprecated)
- Manual routine tasks of users





PowerBI

Power user driven self service reporting and analytics tool.

Capabilities

- Gather insights on business data to help drive decisions
- Report status, progress, etc. from data sources
- Interactive dashboards and self-service discovery

Pros

- Clean, click to build, interface, no code required
- Integrates with hundreds of SaaS providers as well as onprem data
- Upload an Excel file and get started

Cons

Costly, E5 needed for sharing reports and dashboards

- Excel reports and charts
- Custom reporting widgets and charts

Pros

Easy to use task management tool

Cons

• Doesn't fully integrate across O365

- Excel, Pen & Paper
- Wunderlist, Trello



Planner

Project and team task management

Capabilities

- Managing teams' tasks
- Quickly see status of project through multiple views

Pros

- Easy to use task management tool, Kanban board style
- Integrates with Teams
- See your tasks by bucket, assigned to, progress, due date, & label
- Built in charts and calendar view

Cons

• Hmmm...

- MS Project, Excel
- Trello



Teams

Chat and video conferencing providing a window to the rest of Office 365 and other cloud applications.

Capabilities

- Enable persistent chat across the team, in organized buckets
- Securely share files and content with the team
- Host remote meetings with audio and video

Pros

- Integrates across Office 365
- High quality video conference calls, recordings saves to Stream automatically
- Integrates with many other cloud applications across the business

Cons

No offline access

- Slack
- Email
- Skype



Secure enterprise social network for company wide and cross department collaboration

Capabilities

- Company wide communications
- Focused groups for social conversations
- Ask open questions and connect to those who know

Pros

- Central location for company wide communications and collaboration
- Allow users across departmental and geographical boundaries to connect, even with external users

Cons

Hmmm...

- Facebook Workplace, Jive
- Email



Azure

Enterprise cloud services to enable applications on a global scale.

Capabilities

- Secure cloud enabled applications
- Automated deployments
- And oh so much more...

Pros

- Office 365 accounts are stored in Azure Active Directory
- Quickly enable other applications to use AAD

Cons

• Hmmm..

- On-prem data centers
- AWS, GCP
